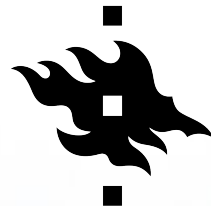

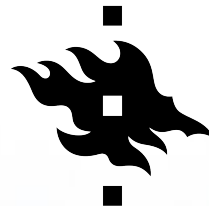

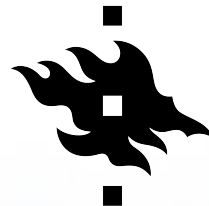
Finnish Research Infrastructures Roadmap 2014-20

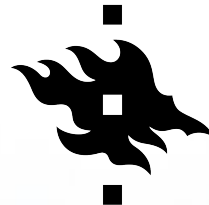

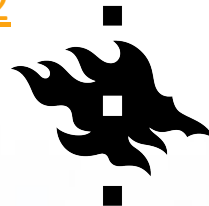

- Also, to examine digitalisation as a cultural and social phenomenon.



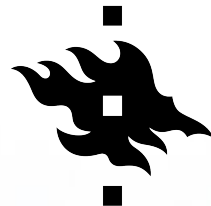
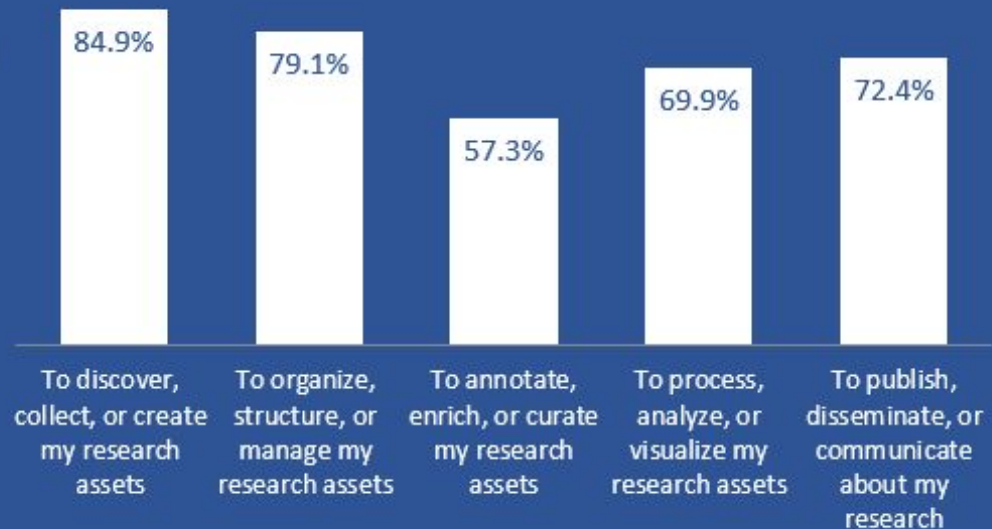

Finnish survey on Digital Research Practice in the Arts and Humanities (October 2016, 239 participants)

Use or interest in using digital methods for research

7,7 of 10 researchers in the Arts and Humanities already make use of digital methods and tools.

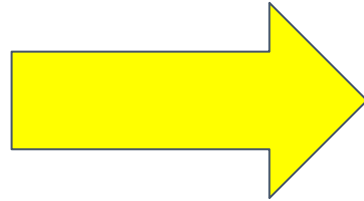
More likely this occurs in initial research steps, for searching, accessing and organising research assets and less frequently in later research stages, for analysing data, creating or communicating research results

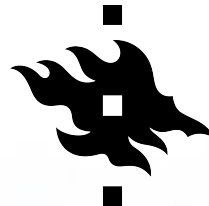
